David D. White Award

On March 9, 2017, Franklin County Common Pleas Court Administrative Judge Stephen L. McIntosh was presented the 2017 David D. White Award by the Capital University Law School and the African American Law Alumni Association.

The award is named in honor of the Law School's first African American graduate, David D. White. Mr. White graduated from the Columbus School of Law (now Capital University Law School) in 1931. The first African American attorney licensed to practice in Columbus, Mr. White practiced for more than 57 years as a partner in the firm of Bell, White and Ross. Mr. White passed away in 1992, and was honored posthumously as one of the first year's inductees into the Law School Hall of Honor.

Capital University Law School and the African American Law Alumni Association have presented the David D. White Award to individuals who have made a significant contribution to the African American community.

Judge McIntosh has served on the Common Pleas Court since 2007. Judge McIntosh became the Administrative Judge in 2017.
